DEFINITION

Hearing Impairment means an impairment in hearing, whether permanent or fluctuating, that adversely affects a child's educational performance but that is not included in the definition of Deafness.

CRITERIA

A student with a hearing impairment who requires special education will meet ALL of the following criteria. For each criterion indicate "Yes" or "No" and provide additional information as appropriate.

- I. The student has a documented hearing impairment by a qualified professional.** Yes No
